The Food and Drug Administration has pirated our copyrighted research, patent and trade secrets to plagiarize and duplicate our suite of computer driven software tools designed to enhance food safety and food defense.

Over the period January 1, 2011 to the current time FoodQuestTQ has written to the Secretary of Health and Human Services many times requesting the opportunity to meet with her to resolve the dispute between the Food and Drug Administration and FoodQuestTQ LLC. Secretary Sebelius has never responded to any of these requests for a meeting.

Please provide all records of briefings, conversations telephone calls and other interactions between Secretary Sebelius and: 1) her staff; 2) the Executive Office of the President including the Office of Management and Budget; 3) Senator Barbara Mikulski; 4) Senator Patrick Leahy; 5) the Department of Justice, and; 6) any other agency of the US Government, regarding the matter of FoodQuestTQ versus the Food and Drug Administration and the Department of Health and Human Services.

We request expedited processing since the results of this request may indicate the existence of gross fraud waste and abuse in the Food and Drug Administration and within the Department of Health and Human Services. The existence of gross fraud waste and abuse involving employees responsible for the safety and security of the U.S. food supply represents a real and imminent threat to the safety of the U.S. public.

We also request that fees for providing the above information be waived based on the requestor's status as a free-lance journalist who intends to broadly publish the results of this Freedom of Information Act request.
